SINGLE MALT

The term "Single Malt" means whisky that is produced by a single distillery. Single Malt whiskies tend to reflect the climate and geographical characteristics of the region they come from. There are five main regions, namely the Highland, Lowland, Islay, Speyside and Island-Skye and Jura.

SPEYSIDE

The Speyside area is situated at the North of the Cairngorm Mountain and goes to the Moray Firth. The area is named after the river Spey. Most of the distilleries take their water in one of its affluent; the Fiddich, the Livet or the Avon. Speyside whiskies are essentially sweet, peaty and smoky in character. They take maturation in sherry-wood well and can be rich and full bodied, medium and light-bodied.
